

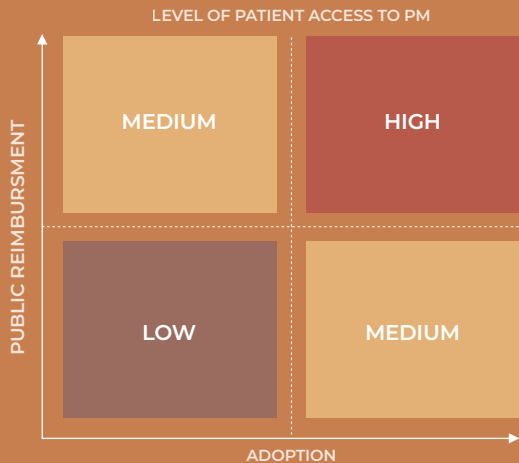
Demonstration Pilots

2024 Impact Report

Precision medicine (PM) has the power to transform lives, yet it remains out of reach for many patients who could benefit from it. Access to PM is highly fragmented, varying significantly across countries, regions, and conditions.

FT3 is a global, open, and collaborative multi-stakeholder initiative dedicated to bridging this gap. By uniting diverse stakeholders, FT3 strives to make precision medicine universally accessible for those who can benefit from it.

Through its “Global to Local” approach, FT3 leverages best practices and insights to drive change at the local level. Local champions lead these efforts, sharing global and local learnings to inspire and scale progress across different archetypes.

Awareness: Key Milestones

Media Coverage

17 press outlets reported [on the press conference](#) and survey findings on access barriers.

Event Impact

7 educational resources developed and 3 patient stories shared via social media.

Access: Achievements in Equity

- Doors opened to regional policymakers. Positioned the local group as a strategic partner for biomarker testing implementation in Spain.
- A policy roundtable in Andalusia with key stakeholders, including the PM coordinator, the president of the Medical Oncology Society, and a molecular pathology expert, resulted in a roadmap with key priorities to accelerate the implementation of the precision medicine plan.

Insights: Critical Success Factors

- Patient group leadership enhances access to medical and policy stakeholders.
- Multi-stakeholder collaborations amplify public reach and impact.
- Strategic timing is vital for engaging policymakers and driving systemic change.

Awareness: Key Milestones

Partnered with **141 Pulmonary Outpatient Care locations** to share co-created resources about biomarker testing and targeted therapies

Created **2 educational videos** to enhance patient understanding & access

Engaged the medical community at **4 key national conferences**.

Key Insights: Access Barriers

- Reimbursement delays force reliance on Individual Requests
- Limited healthcare investment & absence of a national cancer plan
- Urban-rural gaps in molecular centers and histological services
- Shortage of healthcare personnel disrupts care continuity
